

## Lifestyle Covenant for SYC Staff

Scioto Youth Camp was established to fulfill The Great Commission, to "Reach Kids For Christ". The Scioto Youth Camp Board believes we have a responsibility to influence campers in positive, not negative ways. SYC staff members' lifestyles should reflect a right relationship with Christ and alignment with the Biblical standards of the SYC Board.

We are a non-denominational camp, founded on United Brethren principles. We understand our volunteers come from many different churches with matters of differing opinions (such as beliefs on spiritual gifts, musical preferences, etc.). However, the SYC Board believes the following statements to be Biblical truths and examples of a God-fearing life. Therefore, we request that you as a volunteer agree to abide by the following standards and beliefs.

With your signature, on each of these matters, you acknowledge agreement with these beliefs and recognize that you will uphold these standards should any of these topics arise at Scioto Youth Camp. The Board and its Directors may discuss these matters with potential applicants, and reserve the right to decline positions at SYC.

### DOCTRINAL BELIEFS:

1. **The Trinity** - I believe that God exists in three persons; God The Father, God The Son, and God The Holy Spirit (making up The Trinity). While each Person of The Trinity has differences from Other Persons of The Trinity, They are at the same time, One. \_\_\_\_\_
2. **The God of The Bible** - I believe in The God of The Bible. I believe that He created the entire world in six 24-hour days, and that He is the ultimate king of the universe. \_\_\_\_\_
3. **Sinful Mankind** - I believe that all mankind is born with a sinful nature, from the fall in the Garden of Eden, and therefore every person on earth is in need of a Savior. I believe that Jesus Christ is The Savior for whomever has a personal relationship with Him. I also believe that He offers freedom from sin, and while men and women may still be tempted to sin after they have begun a relationship with Jesus, they do not need to give into a sinful lifestyle and sinful habits. \_\_\_\_\_
